## **Statement of Faith**

- 1. The Bible affirms that God has revealed himself through general and special revelation (Ps. 19:1-14; Rom. 1:18-23, 2:14-15; Eph. 3:1-13; 2 Tim. 3:14-17; Heb. 1:1-4; 2 Peter 1:20-21).
- 2. The Bible affirms that God exists in himself eternally without any cause (Ps. 90:2; John 1:1-5; Acts 17:22-31; Col. 1:15-20).
- 3. The Bible affirms that God created the heavens and the earth (Gen. 1; Ps. 33:1-9; Jer. 10:6-16; Acts 17:24-25).
- 4. The Bible affirms the inspired, authoritative Word of God (Ps. 119; 1 Thess. 2:13; 2 Tim. 3:15-17; 2 Peter 1:19-21).
- 5. The Bible affirms that God is one in essence and in three persons (Deut. 6:4; Matt. 3:16-17, 28:19; 2 Cor. 13:14; 1 Peter 1:2).
- 6. The Bible affirms that Christ is the incarnate *logos*, in the beginning with God, and he is God (John 1:1-3; Phil. 2:9-11; Col. 1:15-20).
- 7. The Bible affirms that the virgin birth of Christ was a miraculous conception in the womb of Mary by the power of the Holy Spirit (Matt. 1:1-25; Luke 1:26-37; Rom. 1:3-4; Gal. 4:4).
- 8. The Bible affirms that all human beings are sinners according to God's standards (Rom. 2:1-11, 3:10-23, 5:12-19; James 1:13-15; 1 John 1:8-10).
- 9. The Bible affirms that salvation only comes through faith in Jesus Christ (John 3:16-18, 14:6; Acts 4:12; Rom. 10:13-17; 1 Tim. 2:5-6).

- 10. The Bible affirms that Christ instituted the ordinance of water baptism (Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 2:38; 1 Cor. 12:12-14; Col. 2:12-15) and the ordinance of taking communion (Matt. 26:26-30; Mark 14:12-26; Luke 22:7-23; 1 Cor. 10:14-17, 11:23-34).
- 11. The Bible affirms eternal punishment for those who reject God and rebel against him (Matt. 25:30-46; Mark 9:43-48; Luke 16:22-29; Rev. 20:11-15).
- 12. The Bible affirms that believers will enter heaven to enjoy eternal life in the presence of God (Matt. 25:34; Mark 9:43-48; John 14:2-3; 1 Peter 3:22; 2 Peter 3:13; Rev. 21:1-4).
